

Contest Terms and Conditions

Contest Name:	Legacy Energy Summer Savings Draw	(the " Contest ")

End Date	August 14, 2026	("End Date")

The Start Date to the End Date (inclusive) is referred to as the "**Contest Period**".

1. Introduction and Eligibility

The following prizes will be awarded to participants who are declared winners by the Organizer during the Contest Period. Three (3) grand prizes, each consisting of a \$1000 digital prepaid Visa. Grand prizes will be drawn on July 1st, August 2nd, and September 7th, 2026.

All valid submissions received:

- Prior to June 30th will be drawn on July 1st, Canada Day.
- Between July 1 and August 2nd, will be drawn on August 3rd, Heritage Day.
- Between August 3rd and September 6th will be drawn on September 7th, Labour Day.

Participants, Legacy Energy customers, or other property owners who are currently signed up with another electricity retailer can enter once per each of the three defined contest periods, subject to the following Terms and Conditions:

2. Contest Period

This Contest shall commence on the Start Date and shall continue until the End Date, referred to as the "**Contest Period**". Entries submitted before or after the Contest Period will not be eligible for consideration or prizes. The Organizer reserves the right to extend, shorten, modify, or cancel the Contest Period at any time without prior notice, subject to applicable law and in accordance with the rules and regulations set forth by the Province of Alberta.

3. How to Enter

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY.

To participate in the Contest, entrants must follow the entry requirements as outlined below during the Contest Period. Entries that do not comply with these terms will be disqualified.

- Entrants must be legal residents of the Province of Alberta and have reached the age of majority in Alberta during the Contest Period.
- Entrants must submit their entries within the Contest Period, as defined above. Entries submitted before or after the Contest Period will not be considered.

- Each entrant may submit only one entry. Multiple entries from the same person will result in disqualification.
- Entrants may enter during the Contest Period using one of the three methods outlined below. No entries will be accepted by any other means.
- To enter the Contest, you must fill out the “Lower Your Bills” Form located on the [Insert website name here]. The form fields include: First Name, Last Name, Phone Number, and Email Address.
- Prior to the July 1st draw, entrants must fill out the answer to this question: “Name the regulated utility 'Big Three.’”
- Prior to the August 15th draw, entrants must fill out the answer to this question: “Name the Wires & Distributions companies in Calgary and Edmonton.”
- Prior to the September 7th draw, entrants must fill out the answer to this question: “Name the regulated utility company that is based in the United States.”
- All entries must include the entrant's full name, address, phone number, and email address to be considered valid.
- By entering the Contest, entrants agree to be bound by these Terms and Conditions and the decisions of the Organizer, which are final and binding in all respects.

All Entries are subject to verification at any time and for any reason.

4. Prizes

The following prizes will be awarded to participants who are declared winners by the Organizer during the Contest Period, subject to these Terms and Conditions:

Three (3) grand prizes, each consisting of a \$1000 digital prepaid Visa. Grand prizes will be drawn on July 1st (in celebration of Canada Day), August 15th (Mid Summer Madness), and Monday, September 7 (Canadian Labour Day)

Prizes are non-transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash. In the event that a prize is unavailable, the Organizer reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value. Winners are solely responsible for any taxes, fees, and other expenses associated with the receipt or use of any prize.

Prizes will be distributed to winners after the end of the Contest Period, subject to verification of eligibility and compliance with these Terms and Conditions. The Organizer's decisions regarding all matters to the Contest and prizes are final and binding.

5. Winner Selection and Notification

The winner(s) of the Contest will be selected in a random draw from among all eligible entries received throughout the Contest Period. The draw will be conducted by the Organizer, whose decisions regarding the selection of the winner(s) and all other aspects of the Contest shall be final and binding in all respects. The Organizer will not enter into any correspondence, including email, with non-winning participants.

Winner(s) will be notified via email or telephone within five (5) business days following the winner selection.

As a condition of winning, each winner is required to:

- correctly answer a mathematical skill-testing question without mechanical or other aid;
- complete, sign, and return an affidavit of eligibility, and liability/publicity release

within five (5) business days from the date of the notification attempt. If a selected winner cannot be contacted, is ineligible, fails to claim a prize, or fails to answer the skill-testing question, or return the completed and signed affidavit of eligibility and liability/publicity release within the required time period, the prize may be forfeited and an alternate winner selected, as determined by the Organizer.

In the event of any dispute concerning the identity of any participant, the entry will be deemed submitted by the natural person who is the registered holder of the email account. The Organizer is not responsible for and shall not be liable for late, lost, damaged, intercepted, misdirected, or unsuccessful efforts to notify the winner(s).

6. General Conditions

This Contest is governed by these Terms and Conditions, which are available on the Organizer's website and made available to all participants at the time of entry. By entering this Contest, each participant agrees to abide by these Terms and Conditions, including all eligibility requirements, and understands that the results of the Contest, as determined by the Organizer and its agents, are final in all respects. The Contest is subject to all federal, provincial, and local laws and regulations and is void where prohibited by law.

The Organizer reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Organizer –including, without limitation, government issued photo identification): (i) for the purposes of verifying an individual's eligibility to participate in this Contest; (ii) for the purposes of verifying the eligibility and/or legitimacy of an Entry entered (or purportedly entered) for the purposes of this Contest; and/or (iii) for any other reason the Organizer deems necessary, in their sole and absolute discretion, for the purposes of administering this Contest in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. Failure to provide such proof to the complete satisfaction of the Organizer in a timely manner may result in disqualification in the sole and absolute discretion of the Organizer.

The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any participant that it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest or violating these Terms and Conditions. Any attempt by a participant to deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest may be a violation of criminal and civil laws. Should such an attempt be made, the Organizer reserves the right to disqualify the participant and seek damages from any such participant to the fullest extent permitted by law.

In the event of a dispute as to the identity of a winner based on an email address, the winning entry will be declared made by the authorized account holder of the email address submitted at time of entry. "Authorized account holder" is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an email address by an Internet access provider, online service provider, or other organization (e.g., business, educational institution, etc.) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address.

7. Privacy and Consent

By participating in the Contest, each participant expressly consents to the Organizer, its agents and/or representatives, collecting, storing, using and disclosing the personal information submitted with their entry for the purpose of administering the Contest and in accordance with the Organizer's privacy policy (available on the Website). This includes, but is not limited to, using the participant's name, city of

residence, photograph, voice, likeness, and image for publicity purposes, without any further compensation.

The Organizer is committed to respecting the privacy rights of participants. Personal information collected from participants will only be used to administer the Contest, for related marketing purposes, to contact the participant about the Organizer's products and services, and for no other purpose unless prior explicit consent is given by the participant. All personal information will be managed in accordance with the *Personal Information Protection Act* (Alberta) and any other applicable privacy laws.

Participants have the right to request access to their personal information held by the Organizer and to request corrections to any personal information if it is found to be inaccurate or incomplete.

Participants may unsubscribe from communications from the Organizer, but any such step may impact the Organizer's ability to contact the participant if the participant is a winner.

8. Disclaimers and Limitations of Liability

The Organizer does not warrant that access to or use of the Website or any services related thereto will be uninterrupted or error-free. The Organizer is not liable for any damages, whether direct, indirect, incidental, special, or consequential, arising out of or in connection with the participant's participation in the Contest, including but not limited to, damages for loss of profits, goodwill, use, data, or other intangible losses (even if the Organizer has been advised of the possibility of such damages), except where prohibited by law.

The Organizer is not responsible for: (1) any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by participants, printing errors, or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest; (2) technical failures of any kind, including, but not limited to malfunctions, interruptions, or disconnections in phone lines or network hardware or software; (3) unauthorized human intervention in any part of the entry process or the Contest; (4) technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest or the processing of entries; or (5) any injury or damage to persons or property which may be caused, directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, from participant's participation in the Contest or receipt or use or misuse of any prize.

By participating in the Contest, each participant hereby grants the Organizer a non-exclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, perpetual license to use, reproduce, distribute, display, and perform the submissions made by the participant during the Contest Period, including any intellectual property rights therein, for the purpose of administering the Contest and for any promotional, marketing, or other purposes related to the Contest, without further notice or compensation.

The Organizer acknowledges that, except for the license granted herein, the participant retains all rights, title, and interest in and to their submission and any intellectual property rights contained therein. The Organizer agrees not to claim any ownership rights in the submissions of the participants.

Any use of a participant's submission by the Organizer will include proper attribution to the participant, unless the participant requests anonymity or such attribution is not feasible.

Participants agree that they will not infringe upon or violate the intellectual property rights of any third party in the creation and submission of their entry to the Contest. The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify any entry that, in its sole discretion, violates the terms of this clause or infringes upon the intellectual property rights of any third party.

10. Compliance with Laws

This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial, and municipal laws and regulations. By participating in the Contest, each participant agrees to comply with and be bound by these laws and regulations, and the decisions of the Organizer, which are final and binding in all respects. Failure to comply with such laws, regulations, or decisions may result in disqualification from the Contest. It is the participant's responsibility to ensure that their participation in the Contest, including the submission of any required materials or information, is in compliance with all relevant laws and regulations.

The Organizer reserves the right to modify, suspend, or terminate the Contest if it determines, in its sole discretion, that the Contest is not capable of being conducted as specified in these Terms and Conditions or in the event that any legal or regulatory requirement prevents or limits the Contest's execution. In such cases, the Organizer may, but is not obligated to, award prizes from among all eligible entries received prior to the action taken or in such manner as deemed fair and appropriate by the Organizer.

11. Miscellaneous

This Contest is governed by the laws of the Province of Alberta and the federal laws of Canada applicable therein. Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this Contest or these Terms and Conditions shall be resolved exclusively by the courts of Alberta.

These Terms and Conditions constitute the entire agreement between the Organizer and the participant in relation to the Contest. They supersede and replace any previous agreements, understandings, or arrangements between the parties, whether oral or in writing, relating to the Contest.

The Organizer reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice to the participant. Any amendments to these Terms and Conditions will be posted on the Website and will be effective immediately upon posting.

If any provision of these Terms and Conditions is held to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be struck and the remaining provisions shall remain in effect.

The failure of the Organizer to enforce any right or provision of these Terms and Conditions will not be deemed a waiver of such right or provision.
